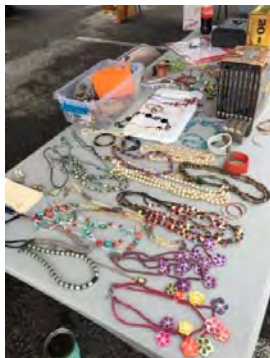


# Clifton Forge Lodge 1683 and WOTM Chapter 22 Hold Flea Market and Open House Saturday October 20th



The Clifton Forge Women of the Moose held an Open House at the [Clifton Forge Moose Lodge](#) on Saturday, October 20. The day began with a free flea market from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm in the lower parking lot of the lodge. Members and the public were able to set up their tables to sell their flea market items without a fee to set up. Vendors sold flea market collectibles like vintage jewelry and collectibles, baskets, Home Interior, Classic Western dvd's and country music cd's, and homemade Goat's Milk Soap from local White Oak Dairy Farm.



From 2:00-6:00 pm, a homemade soup and bread meal was available inside the lodge hall and open to the public. Flyers and posters were distributed throughout the community during the local Fall Foliage Festival and it was advertised in the local newspaper as well as social media. Homemade Chili, Vegetable soup, Potato Soup, Cornbread and Cornmeal muffins and rRolls were served free of charge along with homemade brownies and desserts. Brochures about Mooseheart, Women of the Moose, Moosehaven, Safe Surfing, and Cyber bullying were on display and a Collegian was available to talk to those interested about the Moose organization. A poster was displayed at the entrance with pictures of the Mooseheart and Moosehaven campuses and left up for several days for visitors to view.



Saturday night, the lodge sponsored an open-to-the-public dance with music by the On Common Ground band from 8:00-midnight. The dance was well attended and was covered by the local Alleghany Journal, a local online newspaper.
