



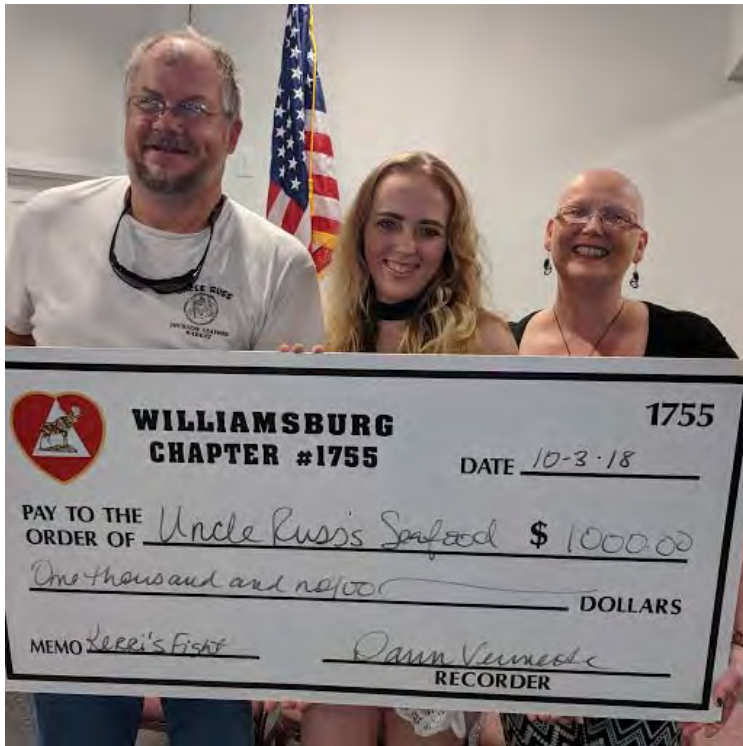
Williamsburg 757 joins Kerri's Fight Against Breast Cancer
