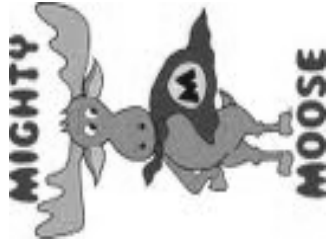

The Holiday season is upon us. I wish each of you a safe and happy Holiday Season.

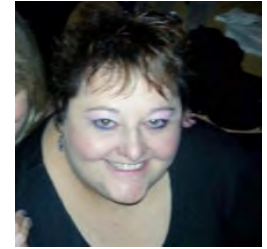

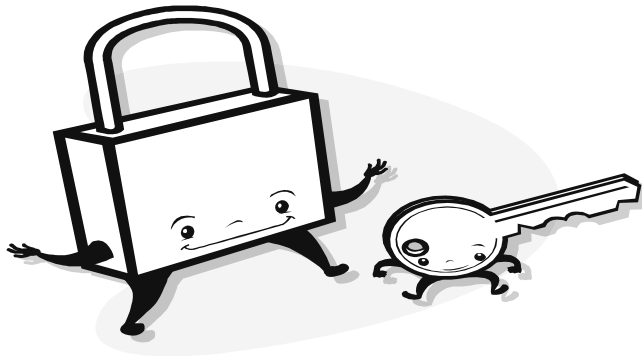

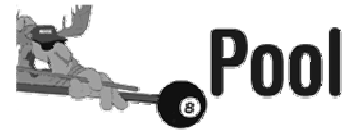
