### 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade

### Building Update

On Saturday, June 22, the general membership voted to approve the expenditure of \$121,000 on the design and county fees for the development of the plans for the new Moose Lodge. Additionally, the general membership voted and approved the expenditure of \$3.5M on the construction of the new Lodge. We have submitted the formal request for approval to Moose International. Your support on this project is greatly appreciated. We are excited about this opportunity to build a new lodge and provide our members with a new up to date facility. The new lodge will be almost three times the size of our current lodge. The permit requests have been submitted to the County and we are expecting to see the permits issued in July with groundbreaking to start in September. Once we get approval from Moose International, we will make an announcement. Look for announcements about the groundbreaking ceremony.

### Board Position Open

We have an opening for a LOOM Board position. The three-year trustee position is vacant. Applications for those interested in running for the position are behind the bar. The trustee is one of the most critical positions we have in the Lodge. They are responsible for overseeing bill payment, conducting inventories, heading up the loss prevention committee, and providing general support around the Lodge. If you are interested in serving on the board, I would highly encourage you to consider a position as a trustee. Your service to the Lodge would be greatly appreciated. Applications must be submitted no later than July 12. There will be a special election held on July 26<sup>th</sup> at the regular LOOM meeting.
