Suspicious E-mail Alert

If you receive emails with subjects related to invoices/overdue payments, or any suspicious emails, please do not click on any links or attachments. When you receive suspicious emails, they often “look” like they are coming from someone you know, but in most cases those email addresses are being “spoofed” and the email is NOT coming from who it appears. Please pay close attention to the “From” address as it will often show the spoofed user name with the actual sender’s name following. For example: **From:** KnownUser@mooseintl.org [<mailto:dadan@ftech.com>], is not actually coming from the known user. The known user’s email address is being spoofed and the email is really coming from dadan@ftech.com. Dadan@ftech.com may be the infected user, or their email address plus the known user email address, are in some 3rd person’s address book who may be the infected user. **Please delete these emails and DO NOT click any links or attachments.**

If the applicant completes one or more of the optional criteria below. He/she will qualify for a chance for a \$5,000 scholarship:

- **In-School / Extra-Curricular activities** (i.e. school sports teams, band, chess club, theater, etc.)
 - To satisfy this requirement a school official must verify this by completing their section of the application.
- **Out-of-School activities** (i.e. employment, scouting programs, music lessons, non-school related sports)
 - To satisfy this requirement **Moose International must receive a letter or email from the student's supervising adult (boss, troop leader, etc.) no later than June 30, 2018.** The letter should include: 1) The name, title, email, and phone number of the supervising adult; 2) Details of the student's participation; 3) The type of activities they engaged in; and, 4) The dates/date range of their participation.
- **Volunteer on behalf of a fraternal unit of the Moose.** (To be verified by Lodge Administrator, Chapter Recorder or Moose Legion Secretary on the application or by email, fax or U.S. mail.)
